Family Promise. We will host Family Promise guests again June 26 through July 3. Volunteer Sign-up sheets are on the table in Osias Hall—sign up if you can help out. **Family Promise** is the faith community’s unique response to homeless families. A network of area congregations open their doors to families in need. Families receive hospitality at each congregation for a week at a time, with each family sleeping in their own private area at the congregation facilities. The program is to bring immediate, but temporary shelter, meals, and support services to homeless families. The goal is to restore the families to long term self-sufficiency.

Membership is open to all who are in sympathy with our free faith and are ready to make an investment of time and energy, and a financial commitment towards the support of the fellowship.
